Lisbon, the city built on 7 hills.

Programme

First stop



Belém

We start our day trip with a visit to the Belém district, where you will witness the era of the great overseas discoveries:

The **tower of Belém** (Torre de Belém), still with its "feet" in the Tagus, is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and was built at the beginning of the 16th century. Several important voyages of discovery of Vasco da Gama departed from here. For everyone on board a ship, this monument was the last visual image of their homeland. They would miss it for a very long time or never see it again ...

Morning

Padrão dos Descobrimentos

The 52-meter-high **monument of the voyages of discovery** was erected in honour of the Portuguese explorers, who uncovered parts of the world in the 15th and 16th centuries. From the top, you have a fantastic view and you also get a clear bird's-eye view of the mosaic compass rose and world map on the square.



Late morning

Jerónimos Monastery



The construction of the **Jerónimos Monastery** was started in 1502 by order of King D. Manuel I, who donated it to the order of Heironymite monks. The church is a gem of Manueline style, the typical Portuguese late Gothic style. In addition to the tombs of many kings, queens and others of royal blood, at the entrance you will also find the tombs of poet Luis de Camões, author of the epic 'Os Lusíadas', and of **Vasco da Gama**, commander of the Portuguese fleet that sailed to the Indies for the first time in history, and who died in 1497.

Noon-Lunch

Pasteis de Belém

Some of the tastiest pastries in Portugal are the pasteis de nata (cream pastries). These from Belém are the best known and are made according to a secret recipe. There will probably be a long queue at the bakery and during our Lisbon city trip there will be no time to buy these pastries. No worries! You can find these delicacies all over Portugal!



After lunch



National Palace of Ajuda

This beautiful, neoclassical palace is often overlooked on city tours. We think it is one of the most impressive palaces in Europe with a rich interior, beautiful dining room, majestic throne room and a library to boot!

In the afternoon

Baixa or the centre of Lisbon

Baixa is the heart of the city, starting from Comércio Square, continuing along Rua Augusta with its many shops and where you can also admire the world famous Elevador de Santa Justa.



At dusk



Alfama

A ride on **Tram 28** through Alfama, the oldest district of Lisbon with its narrow, winding streets, is a must during your excursion through Lisbon. This is a popular tourist attraction, so the tram can be packed during the summer. This Lisbon district is the heart of Fado, the typical Portuguese music that fills the air at night.

If there's still time

Surprise!

If you are not too tired yet and if we have time to spare, other highlights of the city can be visited during this day trip. What exactly, we keep that as a **surprise!**
